

Reading comprehension

Read the following passage and answer the questions that follow.

Raw materials

What are raw materials ? Raw meat is meat that has not been cooked. A raw material is something which is processed to make objects that we can use. For example, the main raw material for making a boat is wood; the raw materials for building a house include bricks ,cement, wood and glass.

Africa is very rich in raw materials. Some of these materials are minerals, such as bauxite, iron ore oil, manganese, and pure carbon from which diamonds are obtained. Other raw materials include cocoa, cotton,groundnuts, palm oil and rubber.To be used by man, all these materials must be procesed in various ways.

In the past, Africa has been used by Europe and North America as an important source of raw materials. A very high proportion of them has been exported to be processed in Europe and North America. Thus, tin has been exported from Nigeria so that tin cans could be manufactured. Cocoa has been grown in Ghana for European factories to turn into bars of chocolate, or chocolate drinks. Palm oil has been turned into soap in factories overseas. Iron ore from Liberia and Sierra Leone has been used in Europe for making steel.

The situation is gradually being improved by African governments. 'Instead of exportiong all of our raw materials, why can't we use some of them ourselves ?' they have asked. African countries are now trying to process more of their raw materials for themselves. For example, all the bauxide mined in Ghana used to be exported. Soon, much of it will be sent to an aluminium plant being built in Ghana, where it will be turned into aluminium. This means that one day, Ghana will no longer need to import aluminium, thus,saving money. In addition, more jobs will be provided for Ghanian workers.

There are many other examples. In Nigeria, for instance, crude sugar isn't exported. The sugar you buy in Nigeria is refined at Jebba, and cubed in Illorin. In Nigeria, also rubber is turned into tyres, tobacco is turned into cigarettes, and cotton into clothes. Indeed, Nigeria's industrial needs have increased enormously.So although she possesses huge supplies of oil, most of which are exported to be refined, overseas, her own oil refineries in Port Harcourt can no longer keep up with home demands. Because of this, more oil refineries are planned for the near future.


